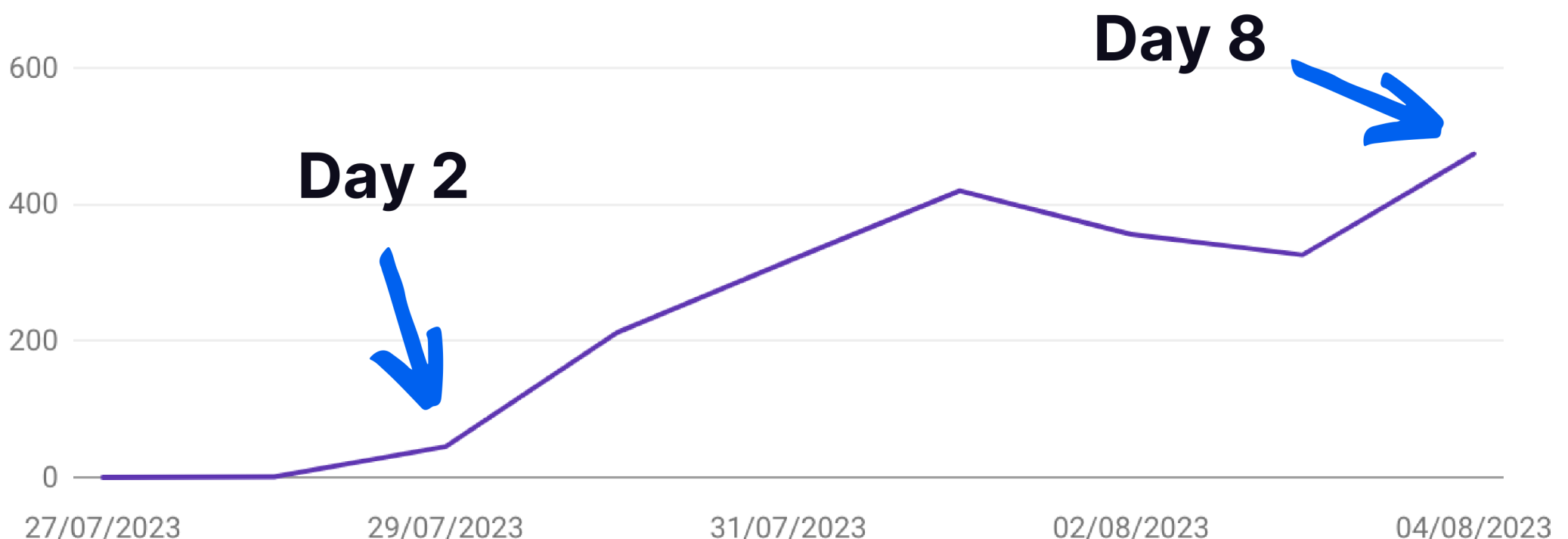


Ranking A New Site In 24hrs



How I speedran SEO
on a new website...



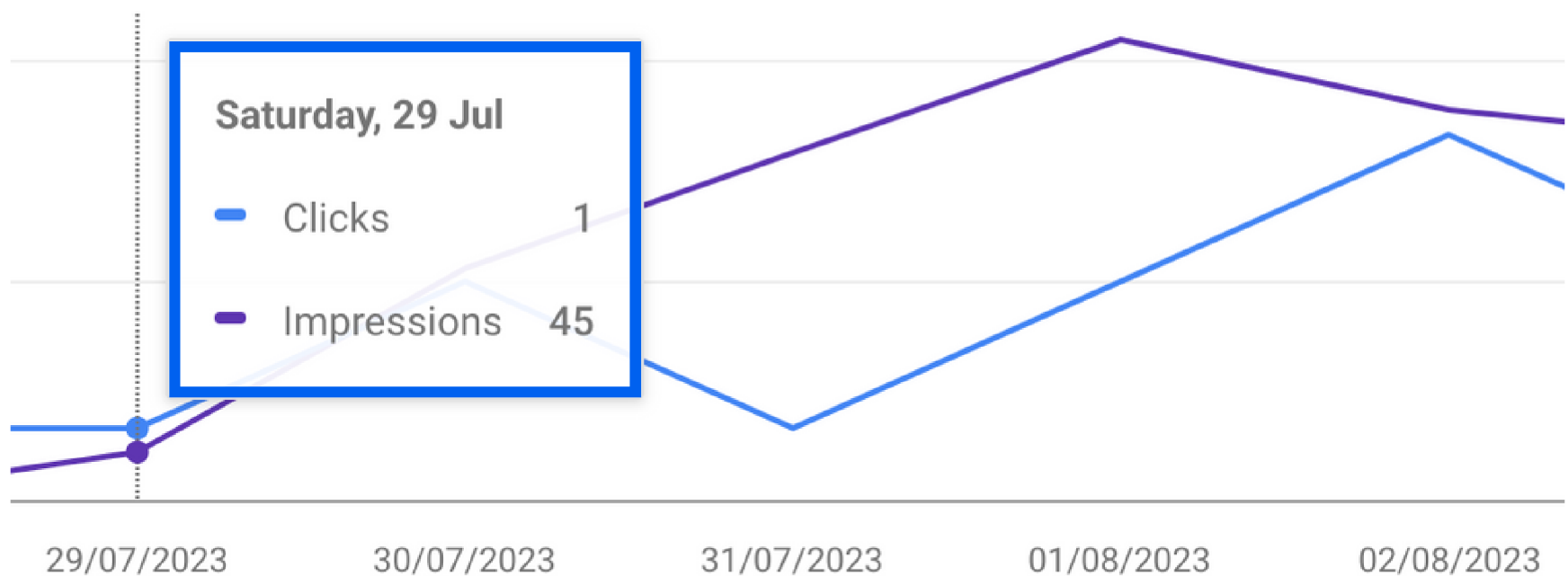
Challenge requirements

- Must buy a brand-new domain with no existing authority
- Start completely from scratch with no content or backlinks
- Use any (and as many) SEO tools as necessary
- Must get traffic from a real Google search with intent for the ranking page

Here's how I speedran the challenge with:

- 4hrs of manual work
- AI, automation, and machine learning SEO tools

To get 45 impressions and my first click from a Google search in 24hrs.



1. Finding the niche

I used Ahrefs to find a keyword structure that had many variants.

For example:

- How to calculate [metric]
- Can dogs eat [food]

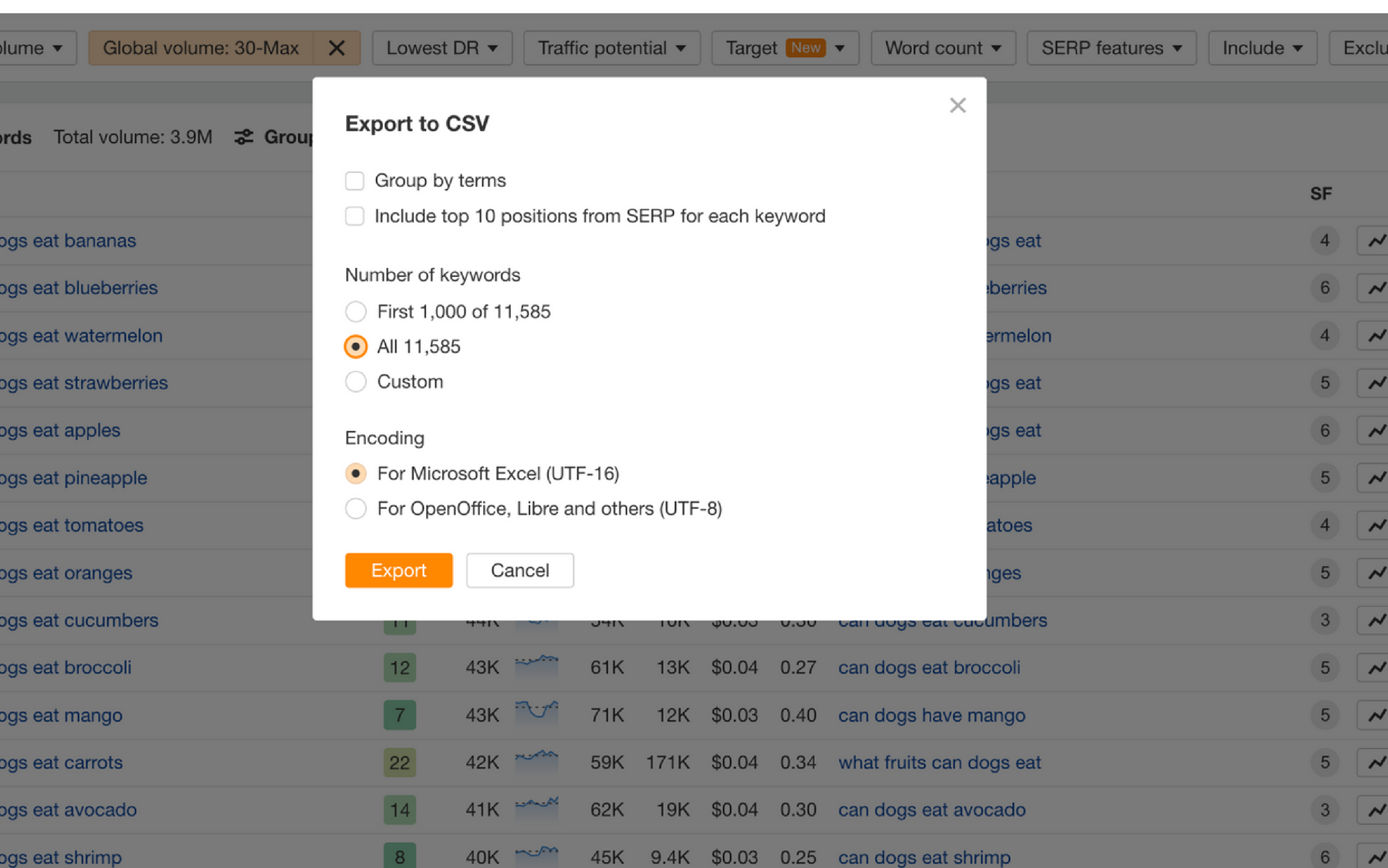

2. Completing the keyword research

Once I'd identified the keyword structure, I filtered the data (minimum global volume) and exported the data as a CSV.



I then uploaded the CSV to **Keyword Insights** to cluster the 1,000s of keywords into topics.

New Keyword Clustering

Keyword clustering involves grouping keywords that are similar to each other together. A “keyword cluster” is a group of keywords that mean the same topically and can be targeted together on a single page.

3. Buying and hosting the domain

I bought a domain closely related to my keyword structure.

CanDogsEat.com, for example.

Then I connected it to **Cloudways** using Digital Ocean for hosting, which sets up WordPress for you.

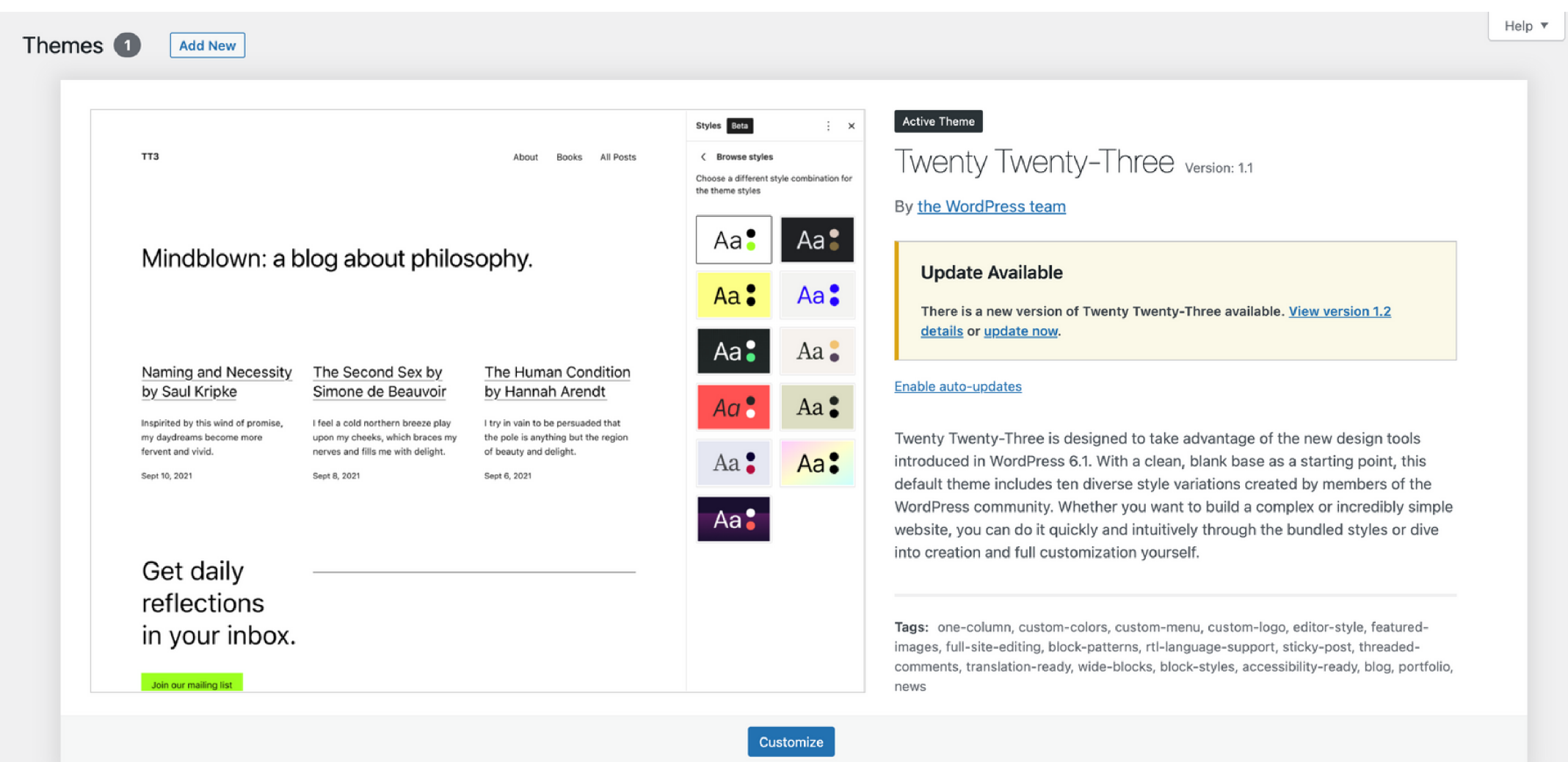

4. Building the website

I used the default WordPress theme and made minimal changes using the WordPress site editor.



5. Creating the content

I then returned to **Keyword Insights** and exported the cluster data to Google Sheets.

6. Publishing the articles quickly

I integrated Byword with WordPress to automatically publish the articles.

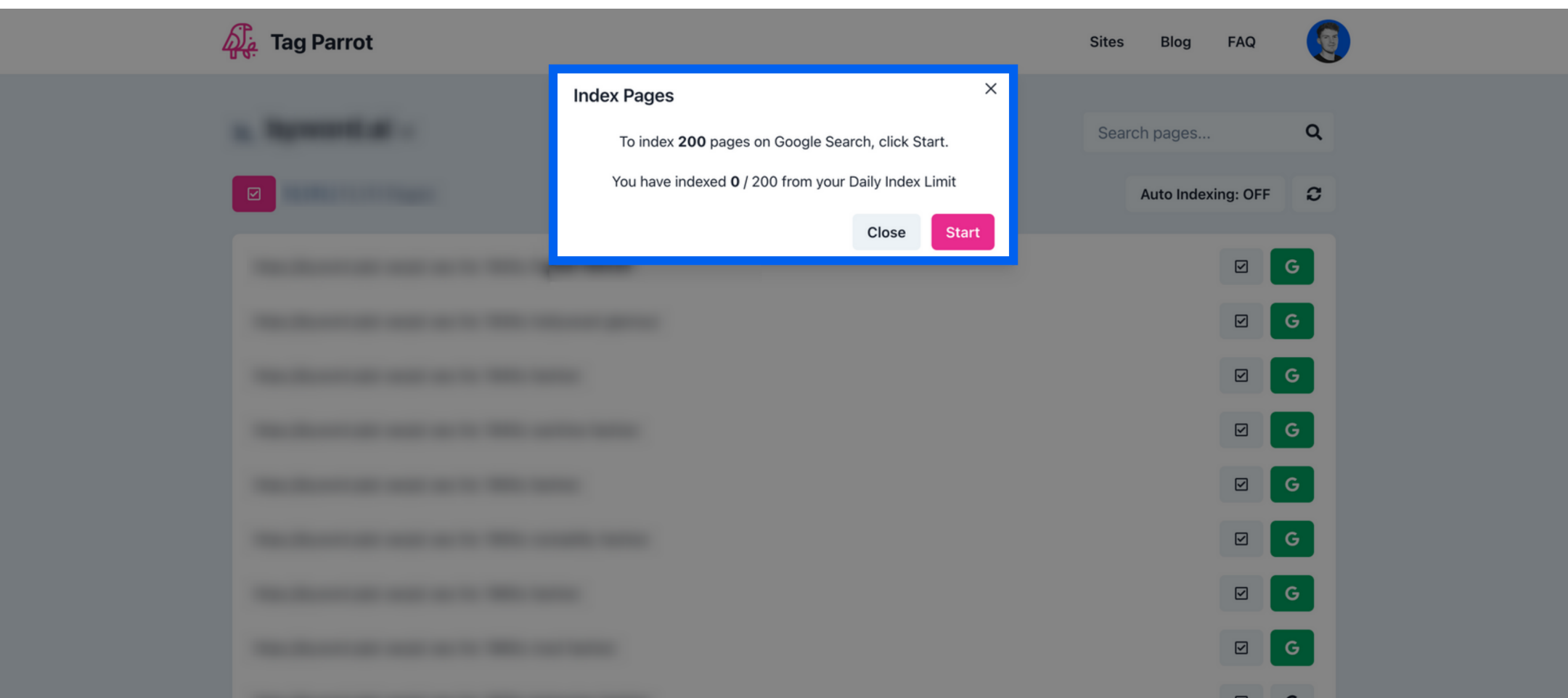

7. Indexing the new pages in hours

I published 1,000 pages on my brand-new domain.

To get indexed quickly, I used **Tag Parrot** to automatically submit my pages for indexing in Google Search Console (at scale).



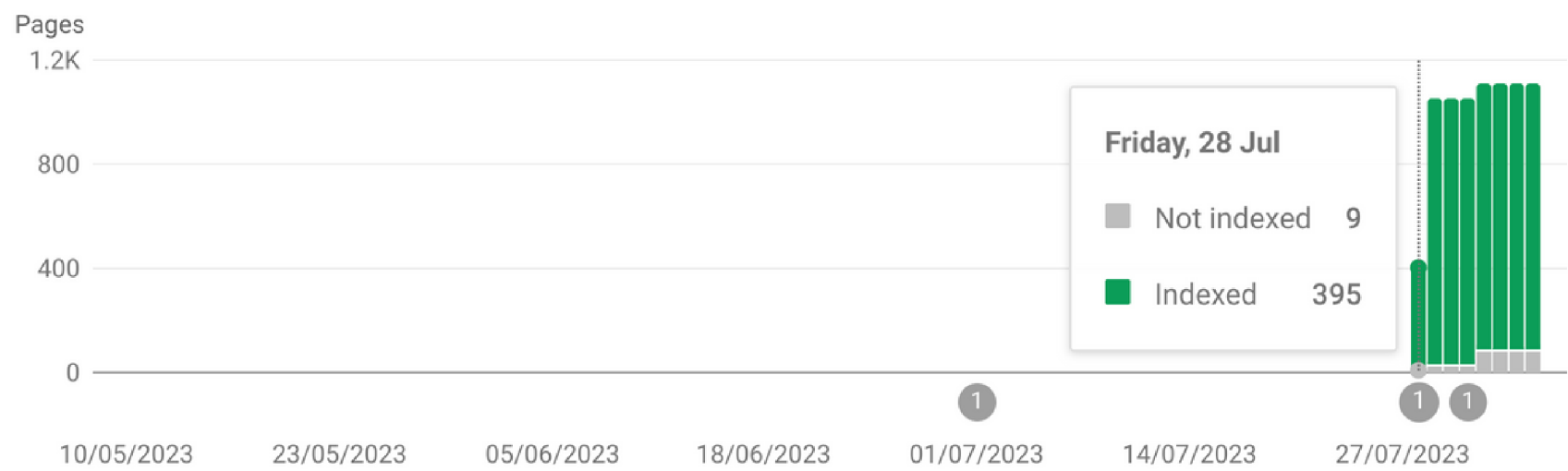
Results after 10 days

- On the same day, 395 pages were indexed in Google
- All 1,000 pages were indexed on the following day
- In 24hrs, the site had 45 impressions on the first click
- After 10 days, the site has had 3,080 impressions and 34 clicks
- 276 pages have had impressions from Google, ranking for over 1,000 keywords

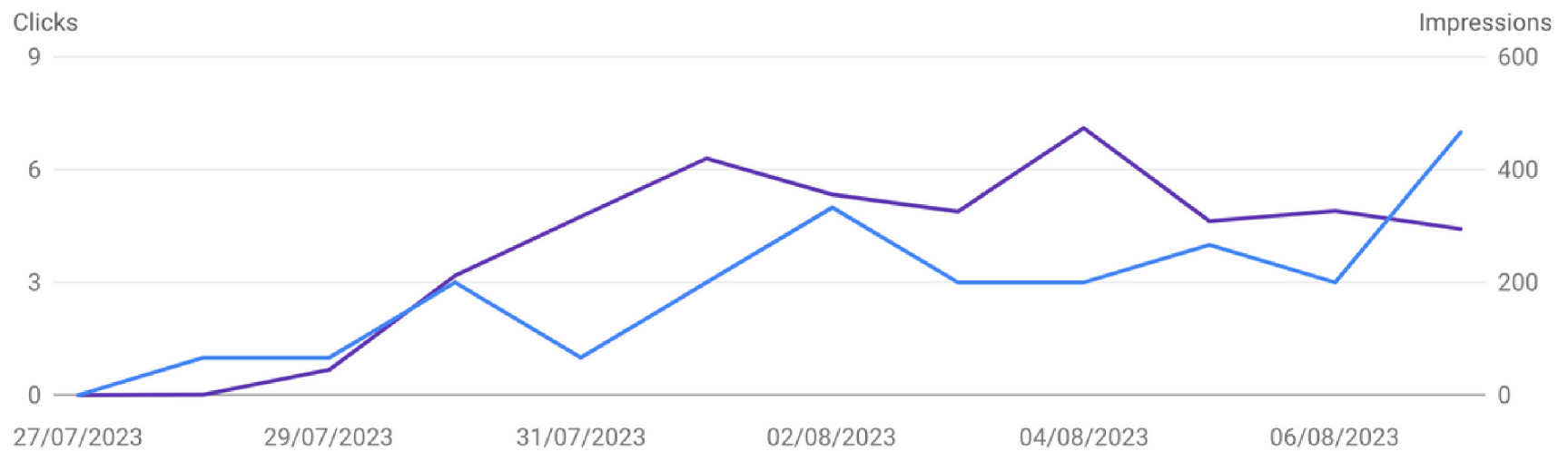

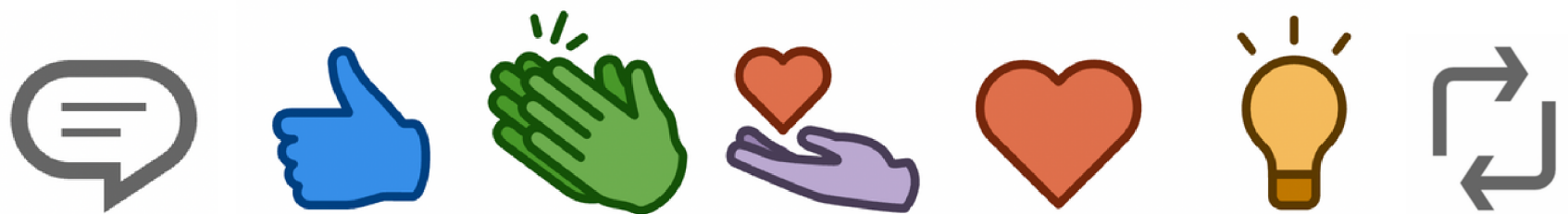
